9 We are unknown nobodies whom everyone knows. We are frequently at death's door, yet here we are, still alive! We have been severely punished yet not executed. 10 We may suffer, yet in every season we are always found rejoicing. We may be poor, yet we bestow great riches on many. We seem to have nothing, yet in reality we possess all things.

Joel 3:9 (NIV)

9 Proclaim this among the nations: Prepare for war!
Rouse the warriors! Let all the fighting men draw near
and attack.

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 (TPT)

3-4 For although we live in the natural realm, we don't wage a military campaign employing human weapons, using manipulation to achieve our aims. Instead, our spiritual weapons are energized with divine power to effectively dismantle the defenses behind which people hide. 5 We can demolish every deceptive fantasy that opposes God and break through every arrogant attitude that is raised up in defiance of the true knowledge of God. Mark 11:23-24 (TPT)

23 Listen to the truth I speak to you: If someone says to this mountain with great faith and having no doubt, 'Mountain, be lifted up and thrown into the midst of the sea,' and believes that what he says will happen, it will be done. 24 This is the reason I urge you to boldly believe for whatever you ask for in prayer—believe that you have received it and it will be yours.

Let your Holy Spirit lead me and guide me today and fill me with all needed gifting and grace to walk in my purpose of bringing heaven down to earth! Let your word be like a fire shut up in my bones and let your infectious love be so contagious to those I come in contact with today! I claim my neighborhood, school, job, family, and friends for Jesus and cover them with the redeeming blood of Jesus! I declare that the enemy is under my feet and shall remain there all day and night! I claim the favor of God over my family, my mind, my body, my home, my finances and my future hopes and dreams! I take up the shield of faith which can extinguish ALL the flaming arrows the enemy tries to shoot at me! I declare that I am Healed and Whole by the power of Jesus! Speak through me with your Holy Spirit to those you place in my path! I pray all of this in the powerful name of Jesus! **Amen**
